## Suggestions for Using

# "Evaluation and Measurement of Data Sources in Your Organization"

## **Objectives:**

- · Identify data sources for use in measurement and evaluation
- Generate discussion about and creativity in tapping data sources

#### **Intended Audience:**

- Diversity council or task force members designing evaluation strategy
- · Leaders and managers giving input to evaluation strategy

#### **Processing the Activity:**

- Facilitator leads a discussion of evaluation levels and purposes, as well as hard and soft data.
- · Participants working individually fill out the chart listing sources of data.
- Participants form small groups, pooling their information, charting, and then reporting collected responses.
- Facilitator leads total-group discussion of prime sources and methods for gathering needed data.

## **Questions for Discussion:**

- · Where do we have the most data already?
- · What would we need to do with existing data to make them useful?
- · What data do we still need?
- What are the best ways to get them?

## **Caveats, Considerations, and Variations:**

- The organization needs to be prepared for and willing to deal with any data that are collected.
- · There may be confidentiality issues and personnel policies governing the use of some sources.
